


## **Bullseye Nazgul Waller Rod**



The two-piece, slim and very light blank works powerfully, dynamically and under load, despite initial tip action, semi-parabolic and very harmonious. It wonderfully cushions the flees from the catfish and as a result fish are tired in a short time. This is particularly important when it is necessary to get a fish out of the channel quickly or to keep it away from an underwater obstacle. The black, matt lacquered blank is the heart of the rod and only the very best components are used. For example, we had an end cap made of a very robust hard rubber specially for this purpose. In addition, the solid Duplon handle, which is optimally dimensioned for the needs of catfish fishing, a FUJI DPS-22 screw reel seat and the FUJI K ring are the essential features of this high-quality rod. Other features include the underwinding of the rings, a counter ring on the screw reel seat that prevents the reel from loosening and the Grip Paint painted areas around the connector that allow for better disassembly of the rod. In addition, the hand and tip sections have discreet dot markings, making it easier to align both rod sections straight in line with the ring alignment. All NAZGUL rods are supplied in a robust neoprene case. This has an opening so that the rods can be transported safely even with the reel mounted.

## Nazgul 2,60m:

The NAZGUL 260 has been developed for modern, stationary catfish fishing. With it, you are optimally equipped for the vast majority of situations. It is predestined for all facets of U-pose fishing. It doesn't matter whether it's shore or boat fishing. The catfish mounts are usually taken out on the boat and the fish are drilled from there. The length of 2.60 m is ideal for this, because it makes handling very flexible and all movements are possible without any effort. The test curve is 30 lbs.

## Nazgul 3,00m:

The NAZGUL 300 LR (Long Range) is always used when you fish at long range and want to keep the line above the water. This is the case, for example, when casting to the opposite shore, when buoy fishing or also when casting a long way round. For this purpose we decided on a rod length of 3 metres, because a longer

rod makes it much easier to lift the line. In return, the NAZGUL 300 LR has a little more power in the upper third compared to the 260 version. It is the ultimate, superior all-rounder. The test curve is 40 lbs.
