Plus, it's unbelievably stable in the water even when casting to the sides - even with big, heavy anglers.

The Slayer Propel 13 has been designed to easy-adapt to your personal preferences: from bow to stern, it provides mounting rails for easy installation of various Railblaza or Cannon mounts and rod holders and the seat is adjustible in height and distance to the pedals. Equip it completely or leave it at a minimum - it's up to you. The large, open storage compartment of the Slayer Propel 13 combines plenty of space with easy handling and accessibility.

The kayak offers unsurpassed opportunities for use: drive your home lake to catch bass and on another day, let the pedal drive at home and paddle on a rocky river to catch some trouts.

So, how fast can it go?

At a relaxed pedaling you can reach 7 km/h (4.2 mph) all day long, and when there's a thunderstorm coming, you can reach up to 10 km/h (6.2 mph) if you pedal hard. Depending on load, draft, current, wind and physical condition.

The flat profile of the kayak works well in the wind, especially at higher speeds and can be easily steered with the left-mounted rudder control. The pedal unit is built for a minimum depth of 30 - 45 cm - depending on the load.
